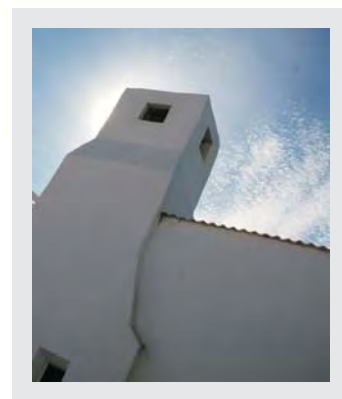
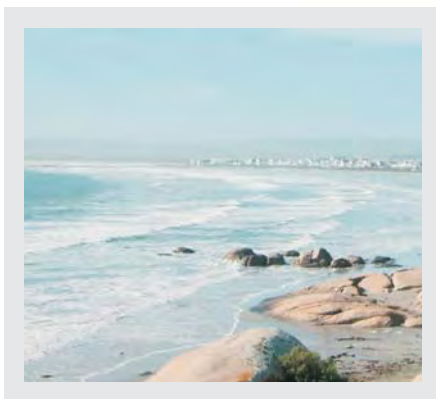
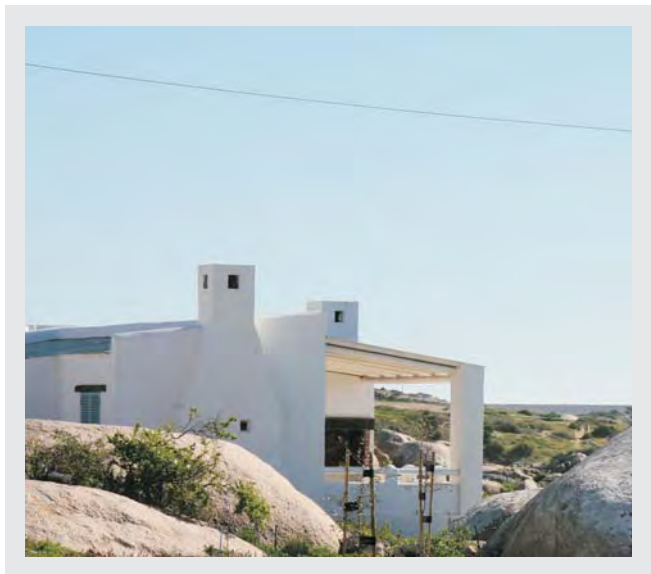


Paternoster - A place where yesterday and today meets in harmony...

Steer your boat away from the everyday retail and concrete jungle. With nature on your doorstep you'll find serene peacefulness for body and soul. The endless pristine sandy beaches invite you to go for long walks, watch the whales and dolphins frolic in the waters. Breathtaking sunsets and the millions of indigenous flowers which open and densely carpet the earth in bright bursts of colour in spring time await you in Paternoster.

As one of the most popular destinations on the West Coast, this picturesque village is well known for its crayfish, snoek, mussels and other seafood delights, birds, flowers and boulders and the whitewashed fishermen's cottages against the cobalt blue of the Atlantic Ocean. Paternoster offers among other things hiking, sea kayaking, sailing, windsurfing, kite boarding, fishing and bird watching. The West Coast is littered with shipwrecks. Local diving will take you on a wreck dive and give you the history of each wreck on the coast. You can go horse riding, visit the West Coast Fossil Park and see the remains of mega tooth sharks, sabre-tooth cats the size of lions, giant ostrich, extinct elephants and much more.

Tietiesbaai, situated in the Columbine Nature Reserve is well worth a visit as this is an unspoilt wilderness area. When the fishing boats return, treat yourself to crayfish, galjoen or hotnosvis - for nothing comes close to the smell of an open fire and the taste of fresh crayfish accompanied by cold, crisp white wine from the area's wineries. Paternoster is a mere 145km north of Cape Town on the R27 coastal road. It is an all year round destination and enjoys a Mediterranean climate - mildly hot summers and mild but wet winters.
